
#### 1. Grand Hotel Oslo - Oslo

This iconic hotel, situated by the Sognefjord, blends traditional wooden architecture with modern hospitality.


Although not a casino hotel, it offers a tranquil retreat ideal for those enjoying scenic views and online gaming.
